




BORN THIS WAY

Some female bears will give birth in the den during torpor. Baby bears are called cubs. Despite being some of the largest land predators on the planet, cubs start life as small, toothless creatures that are unable to hear, smell or see, and are only covered in a few fine hairs. It can take a month and a half for some bear cubs to open their eyes for the first time.

A newborn baby panda only weighs times smaller than its mother.



Newborn cubs rely on their mother's milk for food. This is called 'nursing'. While spectacled bears typically nurse for only eight weeks, sloth bears may nurse for up to two years! Bear milk in colder regions can be around ten times fattier than that of humans, and polar bear milk is so thick that it looks more like condensed milk (and smells like fish). This rich diet is perfect for building the strength of these would-be hunters.

AQUATIC ANOMALIES

Rivers, lakes, and springs have historically attracted human ritual, in the form of temples, offerings, and stories. Local tales warn that waterways are inhabited by monsters and spirits. Folklorists often suggest the stories are parabolic, meant to deter youths from dangerous waters.

In legend, Loch Ness in Scotland has been home to an aquatic monster since at least the 6th century. Contemporary interest was sparked in 1933 when *The Inverness Courier* reported a sighting by a vacationing English couple. Nicknamed "Nessie" by locals, the monster became the muse



An Irregular Reptile

Many believe that the Loch Ness Monster is a *plesiosaur*, an ancient predatory reptile that went extinct with the dinosaurs around 65 million years ago. This hypothesis is not accepted by most experts in the natural sciences.



Fish, Elephants, and Submarines


Alleged photos, sketches, and videos have regularly appeared in the press. Skeptics suggest a range of animals may have been mistaken for the monster, including circus elephants, otters, eels, and large fish. The "Surgeon's Photograph" (1934), shared in newspapers in the 20th century, is easily the most famous alleged picture of the monster. In 1975, the Sunday Telegraph claimed the photo was hoaxed by sculpting a reptilian head on to a toy submarine.
