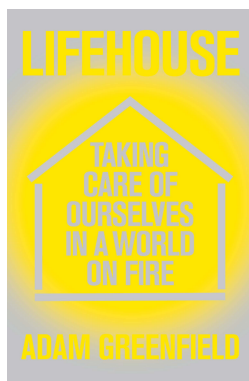


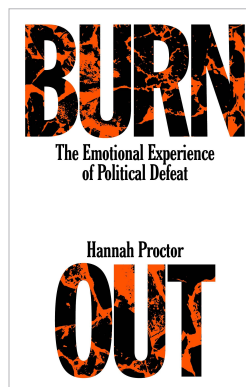

A manifesto and guide for building mutual aid groups and reclaiming power in a time of perpetual crisis

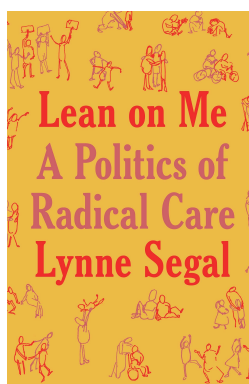

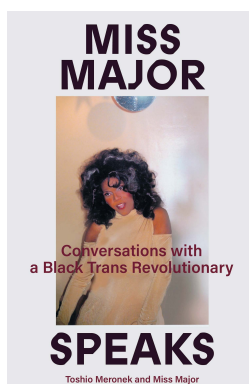

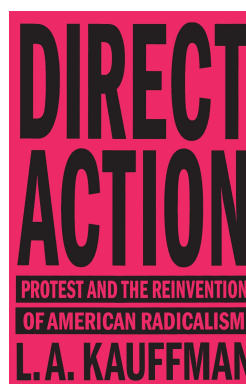
